- I The Meeting was called to by Acting President John T. Whiting at 12:05
- II Topic VI., Committee Reports, C., Public Relations/Marketing Committee was moved to the start of the meeting while waiting for Directors to Arrive. The topic and history of discussion regarding the connecting and/or consolidating the MC website page "Adaptive Sports Program" with the ASPMC.org non-profits web site was discussed. Charles Blier agreed to discuss the matter with MC Marketing and report on how this goal might be accomplished.
- III A motion was made by Matt Castelluccio and seconded by Time Stone to waive the reading of the Minutes of the Friday March 2019 Meeting and approve the Minutes. (copy attached) The motion was unanimously passed
- IV The Treasurer's Report was presented by Secretary/Treasurer Buffy Whiting. She reported an existing balance of \$1,985.66 and acknowledged donations made by Hidden Valley Closed Golf Classic, Tim Stone, John Kelly and receipt of a donation from the John Whiting's Birthday Facebook Fundraiser and the Network for Good.

- VII Old Business
  - A. The need to hold an Annual Meeting to re-elect and nominate new Board Members and elect Officers was discussed. It was announced that the next meeting would be designated as the Annual Meeting of the Adaptive Sports Program at Mountain Creek non-profit. The agenda would include:
    - 1. The nomination of two new Board Members to replace Dan Monzo and John Swartwood. (the bylaws state "*At no time may the number of Directors be less than seven (7)*")
    - 2. The nomination and election/re-election of Board Officers (The bylaws state "Officers of the Corporation shall be re-elected at the annual meeting of the Board of Directors, and shall serve for one year or until their replacements are elected and qualified."
    - 3. The nomination and election of Board Members (the bylaws state "*The incorporating Board of Directors shall serve initial terms of three years unless otherwise asked and agreed upon by a majority of the Board of Directors.*")

John Whiting will provide the Board Members with an outline of the actions needed to nominate and elect Board Members and Officers and soliciting nominations for new Board Members and Officers.

Tim Stone and Matt Castelluccio suggested names of potential Board Member candidates and agreed to develop a profile of each along with contact information and share it with John Whiting to be included in the action information.

B. Matt Castelluccio discussed some ideas concerning the development of A Presentation of Ideas for Adaptive Program at Mountain Creek for summer program offerings in the future. A variety of options are being explored including mountain biking and kayaking to be tested for their viability with a presentation of recommendations at a future Board Meeting.

#### ASP at MC Operations Committee Update

- Overall Health of The Program
  - a. In the 2018/2019 winter season, the ASP at MC program grew substantially in both guest and instructor participation.
  - b. This year, the ASP at MC trained a total of 11 instructors to assist guests with varying disabilities to learn a winter sport.
  - While training and continue their education, we facilitated lessons for 26 unique individuals.
  - d. Steve Baumann was transitioned into the position of "ASP at MC Champion" and was able to organize incoming applications, guest profiles, and instructor logs.
  - e. A new space located in the snow sports school building was dedicated to the storage of files and equipment for the ASP which proved to be one of the greatest achievements.
- II. Goals for 2020
  - This pre/early season, we will continue to develop those instructors who are already trained.
  - b. Operationally, our goal is to grow the program to 50 unique participants for the 19/20 season.
- III. Needs for 2020
  - a. We are recruiting for 5 new instructors for the upcoming season.
  - b.- We will have some equipment needs
    - i. Two of our mono ski shocks need to be rebuilt/replaced
    - ii. We have some strap that needs to be sewn (in house)
    - We should consider purchasing vests to designate staff that are teaching adaptive lessons when on the hill.
